My name is Allison Locascio, I live at 1850 Checker Rd. Being on the corner of Checker and Schaeffer Rds I have witnessed an unfortunate amount of hazardous activities from unregulated traffic that puts Long Grove residents, visitors to the area, children boarding/unboarding school buses, our pets, etc. at daily risk.

As I have mentioned before, we have no shoulder on the roads, no bike lanes, and no sidewalks in this area. There is an unmanageable amount of speeding cars and cut through traffic (according to the Lake County Sheriff who stopped by to tell me he couldn't write tickets fast enough one morning - and he issued around 12 tickets in an hour). However, this is pedestrian heavy area with no option other than to use these roads. There has been an increase in pedestrian activity with the completion of the Buffalo Creek Forest Preserve project. That being said, safety must take priority right away.

The board has been made fully aware of these dangerous situations repeatedly. The village engineer has spent an enormous amount of time finding suitable solutions to solve these issues. The idea of creating a pinch to slow and/or reduce traffic is a sound idea. The board has been sitting on this issue with no resolve for years. It is my hope that a resolution arrives today.

It has been an enormous waste of everyone's time watching this issue continuously recycle. By taking no action and knowing the risks at hand, the day will come that blood will be on the board's hands. We have options, please choose one.
