**VILLAGE OF LONG GROVE PROTECTED TREES**

The following species with a Diameter at Breast Height (DBH) equal to or greater than set forth below are protected trees (per Village Code Sect. 4-10-06, Table A; Title 4, Chapter 10, Tree Preservation.) Proposal to remove any protected species trees requires the Tree Removal Permit Application **long form**.
