Application Process:

- 1. Completed Applications are forwarded to the CSC Committee by the Village Office. One or more members of the Committee will contact the Applicant or his/her contact within a few days following receipt of the Application and arrangements will be made to visit the property and discuss the work to be performed.
- 2. The Application will then be discussed in the Committee and a recommendation of approval or disapproval will be forwarded to the Village Board where action will be taken. The Applicant will be notified of approval or disapproval following the vote of the Board. Applicants are not required to attend the meetings of either the Committee or the Board; but, are welcome to do so if they wish.
- 3. Although the Committee and the Village Board will make every effort to expedite the application process, approval may take several weeks. 





Dear Margerita,

I've reviewed the site development plans by R.E. Allen and Associates, LTD., the tree inventory by Sunrise Tree Care and the existing site conditions at 3114 Twin Knolls, as requested.

It appears that most of the trees proposed for removal on the plans have already been removed, chipped and stump ground, as well as some trees shown as being preserved. Tree #'s 42, 79, 80, 83, 84, 86 and 118 were shown as being preserved on the plans but have been removed in the field. Most of the trees removed are not considered protected species and would not require mitigation, except for tree #'s 42, a 10" black cherry in fair condition and 118, a 10" black cherry in fair condition.

I reviewed the limits of the lowland conservancy area located on the north property line and, based on the existing trees shown on the plan, it appears that no brushing or tree removal occurred within the conservancy area.

It does appear that brushing has occurred within the northern half of the 100' scenic corridor along Old McHenry Road (basically to the north edge of the existing berm). This area should be restored to the recommendations provided by the Conservancy/Scenic Corridor Committee.

I have added tree protection fencing to the plans to show where it should be installed so no other protected trees are removed or damaged. This tree protection fencing should be installed prior to the start of construction.

I would also recommend that the tree protection/silt fencing be bumped farther away from tree #195, a 13" red oak in fair condition. The silt fencing should be a minimum of 7' from the trunk of this tree so that mitigation is not required.

I would recommend that 20" of mitigation be required for the removal of tree #'s 42 and 118. The tree protection fencing should be installed in the location that I have shown on the enclosed copies of the plans and the Village forester should review and approve the tree protection/silt fencing once it is installed, prior to start of excavation. The 100' scenic corridor along Old McHenry Road should be restored to the recommendations provided by the Conservancy/Scenic Corridor Committee.

Summary of Observation:

The purpose of this site visit was to conduct an inspection of the work being performed at the referenced address (without a permit).

At the time of my visit, I inspected the rear yard of the properties 1493, 1494, and 1495 Countryside Lane. I found that nearly the entire conservancy area at the rear property of 1493 had been disturbed and was restored and covered in erosion control blanket. The conservancy area was confirmed on a plat of subdivision from Edgebrook Downs Phase B Lot 11. There was no on-going work during my visit. I did not notify the homeowner of the violation during the time of my visit.

At this time, we offer this information to the Village and recommend a full stop work order as we gather more information on the scope of the work that was completed. We also ask the CSCC for their input on corrective action as needed. It is unclear if additional trees were planted/removed and this shall be reviewed by the Village arborist.

It was a pleasure to meet you and Brian on Friday. Here are the plants of concern that I will review with the Conservancy / Scenic Corridor (CSC) Committee Wednesday at 7 pm. That is the next scheduled meeting that will be held at the Village of Long Grove Town Hall.

There are concerns with the following Wildflowers in the Agrecol Sedge Meadow Mix:

- Acorus calamus: is non-native to the USA; species americanus, also sometimes noted as A. calamus var. americanus. Need to verify that native plant / seed is being used

- Cassia hebecarpa has been renamed: Senna hebecarpa; this plant is not native to Lake County, IL per FoCR

- Hypericum pyramidatum is not native to Lake County, IL per FoCR

- Napaea dioica is not native to Lake County, IL per FoCR

- Carex crinita is not native to Lake County, IL per FoCR

- Glyceria canadensis is not native to Lake County, IL per FoCR

- Glyceria grandis is not native to Lake County, IL per FoCR

- Scripus acutus has been renamed: Schoenoplectus acutus

- Scripus validus has been renamed: Schoenoplectus validus
