

Long Grove Open Burn Guidelines/Restrictions: (Updated August 11, 2020)

- 1. Burning of leaves and landscape waste is prohibited.
- 2. Burning of construction materials, garbage and household/commercial waste are prohibited.
- 3. Tree branches can be burned in piles measuring 3'x3'x3'. When the fire protection district grants permission, bundles measuring 5'x5'x5' can be burned. Fires over 5'x5'x5' are not allowed.
- 4. A burn permit is required from the fire protection district to perform an open burn related to prairie conservation. To obtain an open burn permit, an <u>open burn</u> <u>permit application</u> must be submitted to the Village. The Village adds the property to a list submitted to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA). Once the Village receives confirmation from the IEPA, you will be notified via email.
