RE: Public Hearing; Modification of Alternative Energy Source (AES) regulations

At the joint VB\PCZBA Meeting in January the VB send the AES regulations back to the PCZBA for further consideration.

The Village Attorney has drafted an amended version of the AES regulations based upon the input received from the Village Board at this meeting. A PDF "redline" highlighting the changes made as compared to the regulations recommended by the PCZBA last September is attached for consideration and discussion by the PCZBA.

The Village Attorney has inserted some margin comments to highlight policy issues for further discussion by the PCZBA. Additionally, the Village President had assemble some policy items (as part of the January meeting) for consideration by the PCZBA. These are also attached and should be addressed as part to the review of these regulations by the PCZBA.

Consider the following:

- Including multiple "tiers" of regulations for AES systems based on size and type system;
- Establishing enhanced screening, setback, and/or separation requirements for installations above a certain threshold (or "tier");
- Whether the size and/or type of AES installation should be limited within a residential zoning
- Distinguishing between AE systems accessory to residential vs. non-residential principal uses;
- Developing more detailed landscaping and screening requirements;
- Establishing output/usage reporting requirements to ensure the accessory AES installations are
- Technical advances in AES engineering and technology as related to regulations of AES systems; and
- Incentives for incorporation of AES facilities in existing and proposed developments
