

SANITARY SEWER WORK TO OCCUR IN THE AREA: THREE LAKES DRIVE FORCE MAIN REPLACEMENT

As a part of Lake County's Capital Improvement Program, Lake County Public Works (LCPW) will be replacing sanitary sewer pipes located along the south side of Robert Parker Coffin Road from the Archer Road parking lot to Three Lakes Drive. The project also will replace sanitary sewer pipes along the west side of Three Lakes Drive from Robert Parker Coffin Road heading approximately 450 feet to the north. Utility service in the area is not expected to be impacted.

Residents may observe construction activities, truck traffic, periodic lane closures, and equipment noise during construction. Any disturbed areas will be repaired in a timely manner. Construction is expected to start in May and be completed in approximately three months, weather dependent.

LCPW is proactive in maintaining its infrastructure and one method to ensure continued service and eliminate potential environmental impacts is by rehabilitating sanitary sewer pipes. For more information on the project, visit our website at: lakecountyil.gov/ThreeLakes
