## **Economic Development Commission Quarterly Update:**

### **Completed and Ongoing Projects**

- Hosted six informational webinars during the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic to help support Long Grove businesses, which included the following speakers.
  - Sam Toia, President of the Illinois Restaurant Association. who spoke about restaurants reopening in Phase 3 of the Governor's Plan to restart business in the wake of COVID- 19.
  - o Lawrence J. Mackey/Director, Environmental Health Lake County Health Department, spoke about the implementation of Phase 3 of Restore Illinois plan for reopening businesses.
  - Carlos Arévalo, labor lawyer with the law firm of Smith Amundsen, who spoke about the Department of Labor (DOL) and the Treasury Department guidance extending certain timeframes related to employee benefit plans due to the COVID-19 outbreak.
- Played a vital role in supporting the completion of two grant applications under the Rebuild Illinois Program:
  - \$1 million Fast Track Public Infrastructure Grant for structural rehabilitation of East Cuba Road (Status: Grant Denied)
  - \$2.95 million *Public Infrastructure Grant* to fund the Lake Michigan water connection to Long Grove (Status: Grant Application in Review).
- Reached out to all 100 businesses located in the Village of Long Grove. The EDC was tasked with asking several questions/providing information as follows:
  - 1. How is your business doing amidst the COVID 19 pandemic?
  - 2. How can Long Grove help you?
  - 3. What is the benefit of doing business in LG?
  - 4. LG EDC was hosting monthly webinars for businesses on the 3rd Mondays of the month (these ended the first week of June).
  - 5. Would you be interested in quarterly breakfast meetings for LG businesses in the future? What topics would you be interested in hearing for either the monthly webinars or for a quarterly breakfast meeting?

#### **Summary of calls:**

- Question #1: Most were trying to survive the pandemic, and some stated they were doing
  well. Some were closed for a short while then opened, others were open as "essential" for the
  entire duration of the pandemic, and those that we couldn't connect with were closed at the time
  of the calls.
- Question #2: Some people asked for assistance obtaining PPE, hand sanitizer, liked that businesses were added to the LG website, ability to place signs stating they are open, and one specifically expressed frustration about having his business expansion idea shot down by neighbors.
- Question #3: Those that answered stated it was the location of LG as the benefit of doing business in LG, one said that LG leaves him alone to do his business (LG does not impede his business); liked that it wasn't all chains, but unique businesses; would like to see LG market itself as a "destination" and using the bridge as a "tourist attraction".
- Completed a letter to area banks and lawyers, requesting support in promoting Long Grove to clients as a potential site for new businesses (Status: Letter being reviewed by EDC and Village Manager 9/8/2020).
- Established Monthly meetings with Lake County Partners to provide and receive updates relating to business development and opportunities in Long Grove.
- Planned attendance to the International Council of Shopping Centers conference titled *Retail Selection Trends* in August 2020.
- Invited Eric Flanagan, Vice President of Development with Weiss Properties, to speak at an EDC meeting regarding Company's plans for the redevelopment of their newly acquired former CFI headquarters property
- Facilitated the introduction between Lake County Partners and Eric Flanagan (Weiss Properties-CFI property).
- Currently working on an Annual Work Plan that details the goals, objectives, and funding requests of the commission.
- Currently working on the Economic Development portion of the Village website to support a more robust and interactive communication tool for businesses and residents.
- Currently working on a flowchart that will facilitate the procedures, processes, and communication with potential and new businesses in Long Grove.
