Hear about the history of chocolate, how it's grown, sourced, and made. Learn how to taste craft chocolate correctly. Watch a demo to see how to make chocolate and chocolate treats at home! Our industry experts will be here to entertain, educate, energize, and engage the participants into the wonderful world of chocolate!

The Festival includes a Chocolate Expo Tent, Chocolate Experience Tent, and Chocolate Row of vendors, which all feature chocolate makers, chocolatiers, cacao producers, and related vendors selling and sampling their wares and chatting with attendees, as well as:




Event Overview

- 400 Block of RPC closed
- Chocolate Row of vendors will be in that location (similar to Vintage Days)
- We will be limiting vendors to Chocolate related businesses
- 20 vendors can safely fit there with social distancing regulations
- Town will remain open except for that road, which will benefit the merchants
- Brothers Field will have the Chocolate experience tent(s)
- Entertainment / music will have stages located on RPC by bridge, Sunset Pavilion, Brothers Field, and possibly Towner Green based on approval
- Music will be sprinkled throughout those locations to draw people to all areas of town
- We will encourage people to purchase food, drink, alcohol (cash and carry) from the local merchants (as of right now we do not have a liquor license)
- All tickets will be pre-purchased online
- We will have add-ons when people are registering online for the various classes, sessions, and entertainment that have a separate ticket price (*see schedule of events)
- Event will be at 25% capacity in order to follow Illinois current guidelines
- This event is designed to scale up or scale down as necessary
- The event schedule will be varied each day in order to encourage people to make a weekend out of it and purchase the "All Access Pass"
- Have been talking with the Marriott Lincolnshire as well as other hotels in the area to partner with us, sponsor the event, and encourage hotel reservations for this destination town and event
