LIFE AND SERVICE OF CHARLES ‘CHIP’ ULLRICH

WHEREAS, Charles “Chip” Ullrich possessed a deeply held belief in country, serving with honor in Vietnam as a member of the United States Marine Corps; and

WHEREAS, Charles “Chip” Ullrich was proud of his community and country, these were second to the pride and love for his wife Mary Ann, children Charlie, Adam, Barrett, Tiffany, four grandsons, three brothers, and two sisters; and

WHEREAS, Charles “Chip” Ullrich was one who saw a glass as half full and one to never lose faith, his perseverance was rewarded when in 2016 his beloved Chicago Cubs finally won a World Series; and

WHEREAS, Charles “Chip” Ullrich was an individual whose love for family, friends, community, and country was evidenced through a life well lived and countless deeds that did not go unnoticed nor will they be forgotten;
