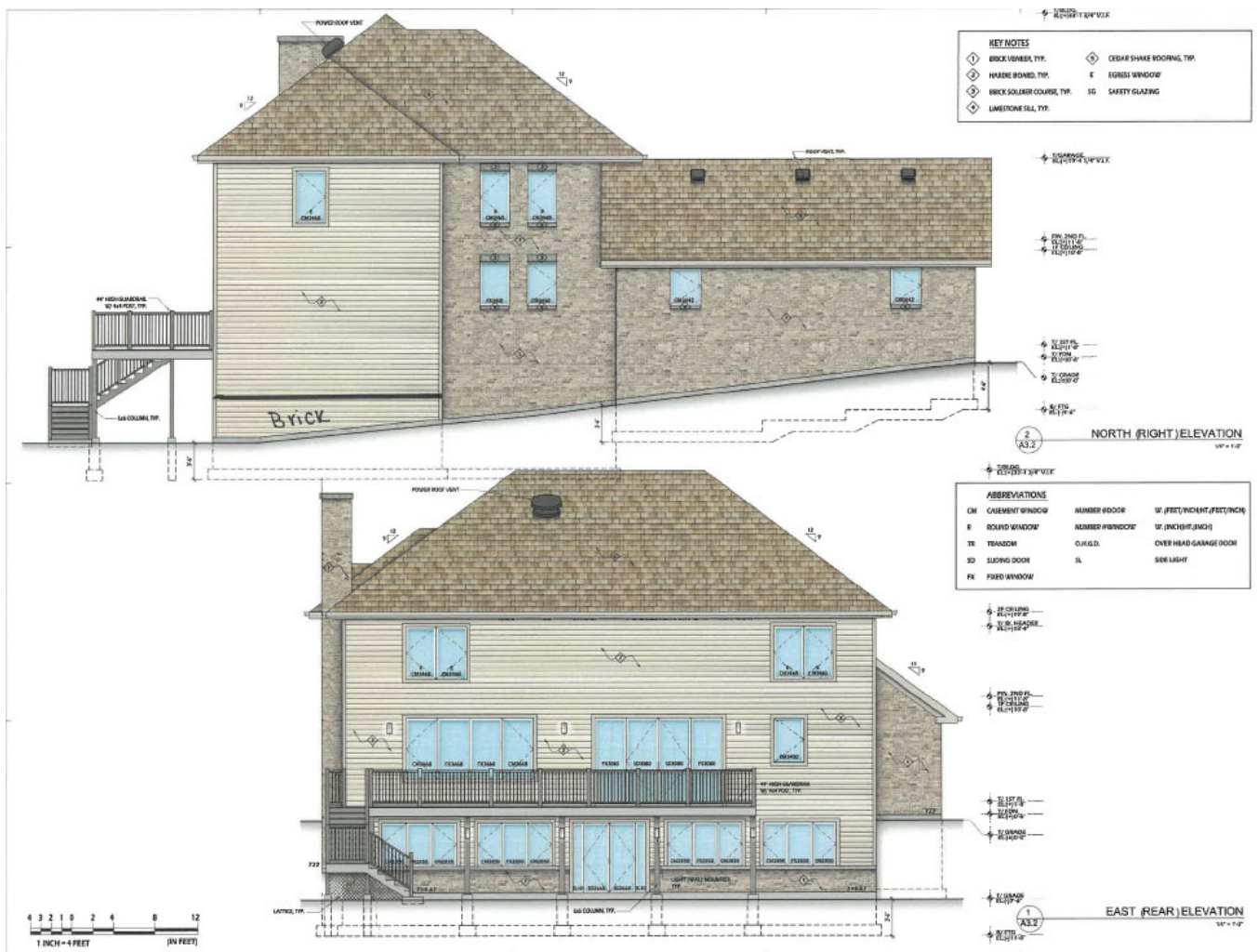

Greg,

The AC meeting went well, they approved the new single-family residence with the following conditions:

- 1) Brick veneer is a listed material, and the commission would like the applicant to use full bricks.
- 2) To add a masonry band on both side elevations to match the existing height of the rear masonry band (see below).

John Marshall and John Plunkett both had some building related concerns and asked me to pass those concerns on to the Building Department. One of the concerns was related the foundation and how it was not up to the energy code and how they will build the step foundation. The other concern was the architectural drawings were not accurately drawn where the Hardie board meets the rear masonry band. John Marshall also asked for us to update him in regards to the outcome of the Building Department's plan review.
