To whom it may concern

We "Chicago Audio Video Design" were hired to do a sound survey at Joanie's Pizza in Long Grove IL. The survey was performed on 3 separate dates on the week of 5/22 Tuesday, Friday & Saturday nights at the height of their busy dinner rush. We performed the survey at the opposite side of the adjoining pond in front of two of the homes. The water fountain was running the entire time. At the time of each survey, we did a head count each time, 18 people on Tuesday, 24 on Friday and 22 on Saturday all were sitting & dining at the outside dining area. At the highest levels we were able to record 74.9 Db. That occurred only during people driving in and out of the parking lot and the sound came from the closing of their car doors. Even at this level this would still be the level of a "Quite Home". During the time when the people were dining and there was no one in the parking lot the Db levels were an average of 50.4 Db. This Level would be equal to a "quite whisper" based on the sound Db meter. This noise was coming from the fountain, and you could not hear the people on the deck at all. Please see the attached pictures of the meter and pictures showing where we were testing from. In conclusion our professional opinion is that adding additional outside dining would not raise the Db of sound that is coming from the restaurant. We feel the restaurant has more than enough landscaping for the sound modification. As stated, the sound that is heard on the other side of the pond is coming from the parking lot and that is where you could add one or two more bushes.
